This is a sample success story:

What do you remember from the KTEL or TLC class?

I remember being amazed at how quickly I was able to double my reading rate, it took less than an hour. I remember that at the end of the class the instructor asked if there were any thing else that any of us wanted. I said I wanted his job, 12 years later I got it. After a couple years training I became the instructor of the course.

What tools or techniques were/are most useful to you?

The importance of looking up misunderstood words if I want to achieve 100% comprehension and full understanding. I keep a demo kit handy for times that I study something that I absolutely want to insure my understanding and recall of.

Have you attempted to help others by showing them skills from the course?

I have taught my children and grandchildren the main points of the class and helped them tremendously in school.

Did the course help you in your job, if so how?

I was a trainer/developer in the computer field. I wrote manuals and taught classes. I employed all of the skills that are part of the KTEL/TLC program in the performance of those tasks. I was skill and ability was widely recognized and appreciated by both my students and by my fellow instructors.

As a journeyman Machine Repairman I was, on occasion, required to train apprentices. I found that if I utilized the KTEL techniques to deliver that training it was effective every time with every apprentice.
